Dear Florida Electronic Library Member,

OCLC has expanded your subscription to the FirstSearch® Base Package provided by the State Library and Archives of Florida to include the OAIster database on FirstSearch and the CAMIO® and ArchiveGrid® databases at no additional charge to your library. In addition, in May you will receive access to an entry-scale, hosted version of CONTENTdm® with secure systems support at no additional charge, to support your efforts to increase access to digital content your library provides. This expanded content is available to you as a result of the partnership between the State Library and Archives of Florida and OCLC.

### Details about the additions to your FirstSearch Base Package

- **ArchiveGrid.** Online access to nearly a million descriptions of archival collections owned by thousands of libraries, museums, historical societies and archives worldwide. ArchiveGrid is an important destination for searching for historical documents, personal papers and family histories held in archives.
- **CAMIO—Catalog of Art Museum Images Online.** A premier resource of high-quality art images from around the world contributed and described by leading museums, all rights-cleared for educational use. Every work in CAMIO is represented by at least one high-resolution image and a description. Many have additional views of the work, sound, video and curatorial notes. CAMIO art images span the following categories:
  - Photographs
  - Prints
  - Sculptures
  - Paintings
  - Decorative arts
  - Posters
  - Costumes
  - Utilitarian objects
  - Jewelry
- **OAIster.** A union catalog of more than 19 million digital resources from over 1,000 organizations developed by the University of Michigan and harvested using OAI-PMH (the Open Archives Initiative Protocol for Metadata Harvesting). Digital resources in OAIster include items such as:

- o Digitized (i.e., scanned) books and articles
  - o Born-digital texts
  - o Audio files (e.g., wav, mp3)
  - o Images (e.g., tiff, gif)
  - o Movies (e.g., mp4, quicktime)
  - o Datasets (e.g., downloadable statistics files)
- **CONTENTdm.** A single software solution that handles the storage, management and delivery of your library's digital collections to the Web. **In May, you will also receive access to full-function CONTENTdm software hosted by OCLC.** Your library will receive three Project Clients for collection building, a 3,000-item limit and 10GB of storage.

The goal of these Base Package additions is to provide your library with access to more digital resources, and to do so in a way that highlights your unique online presence. Connecting these resources through WorldCat® also allows users to more easily find high-quality materials through local libraries.

### Access to the new Base Package resources

**OAlster.** The OAlster database is accessible on the FirstSearch interface through your current Base Package authorization. FirstSearch online documentation now includes details about the OAlster database.

**CAMIO and ArchiveGrid.** Library users will access CAMIO and ArchiveGrid on existing interfaces from February through June 30, 2009 using the authorizations and passwords provided below. Your library's CAMIO and ArchiveGrid authorizations, along with the URL of each service and the location of additional information about each resource, are listed here:

  - o "CAMIO Service Terms and Conditions" are enclosed. Your library's initial CAMIO access via IP authentication or a new authorization will confirm its agreement with these terms. - **IP access.** OCLC staff has made every effort to set up your new CAMIO and ArchiveGrid accounts with access to the IP addresses you currently use for FirstSearch. This should simplify your users' access to

▪ **Libraries with Active CAMIO and ArchiveGrid Subscriptions:**

- If your library currently subscribes to CAMIO or ArchiveGrid, you will receive a credit for the unused portion of your subscriptions. Your credit will be prorated to cover the period from February 1, 2009 to the end of your current subscription.
- Your staff will continue to use your library's existing CAMIO and ArchiveGrid authorization numbers and passwords for access to these databases.

**CONTENTdm.** Details about your upcoming access to CONTENTdm will be provided before this change occurs in May 2009.

**P.S. Integrated access through WorldCat.org is coming soon!** In July 2009, OCLC will introduce a new eContent interface that will integrate access to all of its eContent services (FirstSearch databases, Electronic Collections Online eJournals, NetLibrary eBooks and eAudiobooks, ArchiveGrid and CAMIO digital collections) through WorldCat.org. **The new interface will be available in addition to the existing interfaces for the services listed above. The current interfaces will remain available into 2011.** OCLC will provide details about plans to discontinue the current interfaces well in advance of any changes, to give you ample time to communicate with your users.

The delivery of eContent access through the WorldCat.org interface will simplify information retrieval for your users by bringing together relevant content regardless of format into a single result set.
