Rules and Guidelines



1. The number of teams will be limited to 4. The first 4 complete applications received will be accepted. An authorized representative of each team must sign and return one copy of these rules, along with a completed application, by March 12, 2010.
2. All teams must provide the name of their team captain, and an email address, to which correspondence may be directed. The captain will be the spokesperson for the team.
3. Book Cart Drill Team members who are not attending any sessions, exhibits or events other than the competition, will not be charged conference registration fees. A complete list of only these participants must be provided on the application form. FLA is generously providing these individuals with a free pass to the vendors' exhibition for the day of the competition, this pass does not include food and beverages which are being offered to full conference registrants.
4. DEMCO will supply up to 10 book carts for teams to use. FLA teams are not allowed to bring their own carts.
5. All teams must check in no later than 9:00am at the conference registration area.
6. Teams must bring a CD of their performance music to the Conference. A CD player will be provided.
7. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. Three trophies will be awarded for Best Costumes; Best Decorated Carts; and WOW Factor!
8. Decision of the judges is final. Judging will be based on two criteria:
 - Technical Ability – organization, precision, unique moves, timeliness
 - Artistic Impression – overall performance, music, costumes, cart décor
9. Each team will be allotted 5 minutes to decorate their book carts prior to their performance. One end panel of each cart shall remain undecorated in order to display the DEMCO logo. For reference, the supplied book carts will be DEMCO product 800344 which you can find on

page 997 of the '09 full-line catalog or at <http://www.demco.com/>. It measures 38" to the top of the handles. 28" long and 17" wide.

10. Each routine can be a maximum of 4 minutes. If the team goes over the 4 minute time limit, .05 points for each 10 seconds over the 4 minutes will be deducted from the Technical Ability Score.

12. This event will be videotaped for archival purposes.

FLA shall have the full power to interpret, amend, and enforce these regulations provided any amendments, when made, are brought to the notice of the participants. Each participant agrees to abide by the forgoing rules and guidelines and by any amendments or additions thereto in conformance with the preceding sentence.

15. An authorized representative of each team must sign and return one copy of the rules, along with an application, by March 12, 2010.
